▪ **Independent Study: After-School Programs**

This course introduces students to the growing field of after-school. It will provide students with an understanding of how politics, government, and society have impacted the after-school profession. Students will also become familiar with the components and resources needed to implement, manage, and evaluate after-school programs serving diverse communities. Students will conduct observations in an after-school program.

Spring Semester 2009

▪ **Foundations of American Education**

This course will cover the effects of society, culture and institutions on the developmental needs of children with emphasis on the impact of urban life and the role of the educational system.

▪ **Art Workshop in Education**

Various art media are explored to understand principles, methods, planning and classroom organization necessary to achieve curricular and behavioral objectives of programs in education.
